Assessment Teacher's Manual

This manual provides guidelines for conducting the assessment, examples of how to take assessment data, and detailed instructions for placing students in the Curriculum.

The Assessment Teacher's Manual includes:

- A guide to using the assessment.
- A Present Levels of Performance chart with skill-sequenced levels for each functional academic area.
- The assessment sequence for each content unit.
- Separate assessments for each skill-sequenced step in each unit.
- Directions, response, and scoring instructions for each assessment.
- Instructions for determining Present Levels of Performance and next steps.
- A copy of the Student Assessment section for each assessed area with sample data.
- A list of Assessment Testing Kit materials needed for each assessment.
- The Curriculum Flow Chart for each unit showing the link between Present Levels of Performance and appropriate Curriculum lessons.

Portfolio Teacher's Manual

Program Masters

- A copy of the Present Levels of Performance chart, Curriculum Progress Guide, and a complete set of all lesson plans and data sheets for each content area are included for easy organization of student Program Data books.
- The Progress-Tracking Data Sheets are used with each lesson to record student response and to track learning progress over time. The data sheets provide data-based achievement information to serve as a basis for instructional decisions and for IEP or other progress reports, as well as documentation of academic progress when meeting with parents or guardians.
- The Curriculum Progress Guide shows all the skill-sequenced lessons and associated Present Levels of Performance in all content units. It provides an overview of student progress with space to record the date instruction was initiated in each lesson, the date instruction ended in each lesson, and whether or not the skill was mastered.
- The Present Levels of Performance Chart, along with the Curriculum Progress Guide, provide a summary of student progress over time.

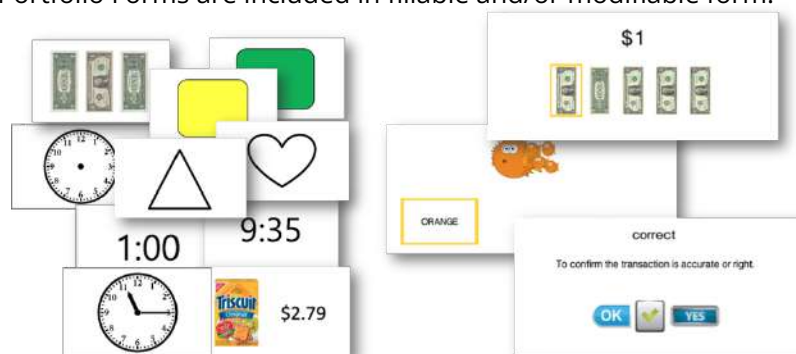

The following program components are also provided on a flash drive:

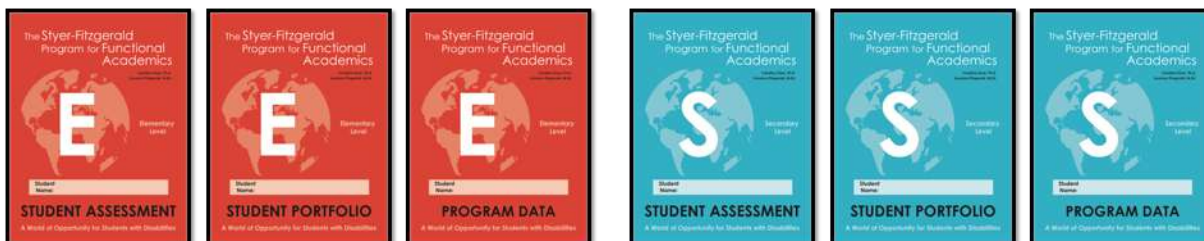

- **Student Assessment book**

The Student Assessment is a spiral-bound record of the student's performance on the Styer-Fitzgerald Functional Academics Assessment. It is used to determine Present Level of Performance and appropriate placement in each Curriculum content area. The Student Assessment includes:

- One initial assessment and one follow-up assessment for each of the content units.
- Present Levels of Performance Charts with skill-sequenced levels in 10 academic and life skills units, along with information on community-based training.

- **Student Program Data -- Cover, Spine, and Tabs**

The cover, spine label, and data sheet tabs are designed to organize the entire curriculum for one student.

- **Student Portfolio -- Cover, Spine, and Tabs**

The cover, spine label, and tabs are designed to organize a portfolio of information about the student that can be shared in an efficient, organized, and comprehensive way.
